COMMUNICATIONS

Overview

- PSAP to PSAP communications about upgrades to alarms is going well.
- Answering the radio (dedicating a dispatcher to MABAS incident)
- Run down of who is on scene to be given to dispatch by command when upgrading alarm.
- Reduction of Box Cards to simplify response.
- Expansion of IFERN 2 capabilities.
- COQ companies understand that communications to take place on IFERN until they are at the station where the company should be on the local jurisdiction's channel.
